## Duaa 1 – When Waking Up

### Arabic

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا أَمَاتَنَا وَإِلَيْهِ النُّشُورُ

### Translation

“All praise is for Allah who gave us life after having taken it from us and unto Him is the resurrection.”

## Duaa 2 – Before Entering the Toilet and After

### Before Entering the Toilet

#### Arabic

(بِسْمِ اللَّهِ) اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْخُبُثِ وَالْخَبَائِثِ

#### Translation

“In the name of Allah. O Allah, I take refuge with you from all evil and evil-doers.”

### After Leaving the Toilet

#### Arabic

غُفْرَانَكَ

#### Translation

“I ask You (Allah) for forgiveness.”

## Duaa 3 – Morning Remembrance

### Arabic

أَصْبَحْنَا وَأَصْبَحَ الْمُلْكُ لِلَّهِ وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ،  
لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ،  
لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ،  
رَبِّ أَسْأَلُكَ خَيْرَ مَا فِي هَذَا الْيَوْمِ وَخَيْرَ مَا بَعْدَهُ،  
وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا فِي هَذَا الْيَوْمِ وَشَرِّ مَا بَعْدَهُ،  
رَبِّ أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْكَسَلِ وَسُوءِ الْكِبَرِ،  
رَبِّ أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ عَذَابٍ فِي النَّارِ وَعَذَابٍ فِي الْقَبْرِ

### Translation

“We have reached the evening and at this very time unto Allah belongs all sovereignty, and all praise is for Allah. None has the right to be worshipped except Allah, alone, without partner, to Him belongs all sovereignty and praise and He is over all things omnipotent. My Lord, I ask You for the good of this night and the good of what follows it and I take refuge in You from the evil of this night and the evil of what follows it. My Lord, I take refuge in You from laziness and senility. My Lord, I take refuge in You from torment in the Fire and punishment in the grave.”

## Duaa 4 – When wearing a new garment

### Arabic

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ الْحَمْدُ أَنْتَ كَسَوْتَنِيهِ أَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ خَيْرِهِ وَخَيْرِ مَا  
صُنِعَ لَهُ ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّهِ وَشَرِّ مَا صُنِعَ لَهُ

### Translation

“O Allah, for You is all praise, You have clothed me with it, I ask You for the good of it and the good for which it was made, and I seek refuge with You from the evil of it and the evil for which it was made.”

## Duaa 5 – When Leaving the Home

### Arabic

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ، تَوَكَّلْتُ عَلَى اللَّهِ وَلَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ

### Translation

“In the name of Allah, I place my trust in Allah, and there is no might nor power except with Allah.”

## Duaa 6 – Supplication at the start of the Prayer (After Takbeer)

### Arabic

سُبْحَانَكَ اللَّهُمَّ وَبِحَمْدِكَ وَتَبَارَكَ أَسْمُكَ وَتَعَالَى  
جَدُّكَ وَلَا إِلَهَ غَيْرُكَ

### Translation

“How perfect You are O Allah, and I praise You. Blessed be Your name, and lofty is Your position and none has the right to be worshipped except You.”



## Duaa 7 – When prostrating due to recitation of the Quran

### Arabic

سَجَدَ وَجْهِي لِلَّذِي خَلَقَهُ  
وَشَقَّ سَمْعَهُ وَبَصَرَهُ بِحَوْلِهِ وَقُوَّتِهِ  
(فَتَبَارَكَ اللَّهُ أَحْسَنُ الْخَالِقِينَ)

### Translation

“My face fell prostrate before He who created it and brought forth its faculties of hearing and seeing by His might and power. ‘So Blessed is Allah, the best of creators.’”

## Duaa 8 – Qunut al-Witr

### Arabic

اللَّهُمَّ أَهْدِنِي فِيْمَنْ هَدَيْتَ، وَعَافِنِي فِيْمَنْ  
 عَافَيْتَ، وَتَوَلَّنِي فِيْمَنْ تَوَلَّيْتَ، وَبَارِكْ لِي فِيْمَا  
 أَعْطَيْتَ، وَقِنِي شَرَّ مَا قَضَيْتَ، فَإِنَّكَ تَقْضِي وَلَا  
 يُقْضَى عَلَيْكَ، إِنَّهُ لَا يَذِلُّ مَنْ وَالَّيْتَ، (وَلَا يَعِزُّ مَنْ  
 عَادَيْتَ)، تَبَارَكْتَ رَبَّنَا وَتَعَالَيْتَ

### Translation

“O Allah, guide me with those whom You have guided,  
 and strengthen me with those whom You have given  
 strength. Take me to Your care with those whom You  
 have taken to Your care. Bless me in what You have  
 given me. Protect me from the evil You have ordained.  
 Surely, You command and are not commanded, and  
 none whom You have committed to Your care shall be  
 humiliated [and none whom You have taken as an  
 enemy shall taste glory]. You are Blessed, Our Lord,  
 and Exalted.”

## Duaa 9 – Anxiety and Sorrow

### Arabic

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْهَمِّ وَالْحُزْنِ،  
وَالْعَجْزِ وَالْكَسَلِ وَالْبُخْلِ وَالْجُبْنِ،  
وَضَلْعِ الدَّيْنِ وَغَلْبَةِ الرِّجَالِ

### Translation

“O Allah, I seek refuge in you from grief and sadness, from weakness and from laziness, from miserliness and from cowardice, from being overcome by debt and overpowered by men (i.e. others).”

## Duaa 10 – One whose affairs have become Difficult

### Arabic

اللَّهُمَّ لَا سَهْلَ إِلَّا مَا جَعَلْتَهُ سَهْلًا،  
وَأَنْتَ تَجْعَلُ الْحُزْنَ إِذَا شِئْتَ سَهْلًا

### Translation

“O Allah, there is no ease other than what You make easy. If You please You ease sorrow.”

## Duaa 11 – When Visiting the Sick

### Arabic

لَا بَأْسَ ظُهُورًا إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ

### Translation

“Do not worry, it will be a purification (for you), Allah willing.”

## Duaa 12 – Condolence

### Arabic

إِنَّ لِلَّهِ مَا أَخَذَ، وَلَهُ مَا أَعْطَى، وَكُلُّ شَيْءٍ عِنْدَهُ بِأَجَلٍ  
مُسَمًّى ... فَلْتَصْبِرْ وَلْتَحْتَسِبْ

### Translation

“Surely, Allah takes what is His, and what He gives is His, and to all things He has appointed a time... so have patience and be rewarded.”

Duaa 13 – Supplication said upon seeing someone in trial or tribulation

**Arabic**

أَلْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي عَافَانِي مِمَّا ابْتَلَاكَ بِهِ،  
وَفَضَّلَنِي عَلَى كَثِيرٍ مِمَّنْ خَلَقَ تَفْضِيلًا

**Translation**

“All praise is for Allah Who saved me from that which He tested you with and Who most certainly favoured me over much of His creation.”

## Duaa 14 – When it Rains

### Arabic

اللَّهُمَّ صَيِّبًا نَافِعًا

### Translation

“O Allah, may it be a beneficial rain cloud.”



## Duaa 15 – Upon Breaking Fast

### Arabic

ذَهَبَ الظَّمَأُ، وَأَبْتَلَّتِ العُرُوقُ،  
وَوَثَبَتِ الأَجْرُ إِنِّ شَاءَ اللهُ

### Translation

“The thirst is gone, the veins are moistened, and the reward is confirmed, if Allah wills.”

Duaa 16 – Upon completing the meal someone has provided

**Arabic**

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَطْعَمَنِي هَذَا  
وَرَزَقَنِيهِ مِنْ غَيْرِ حَوْلٍ مِنِّي وَلَا قُوَّةَ

**Translation**

“All praise is for Allah who fed me this and provided it for me without any might nor power from myself.”

Duaa 17 – Supplication said to one offering a drink or to one who intended to do that

**Arabic**

اللَّهُمَّ أَطْعِمْ مَنْ أَطْعَمَنِي،  
وَأَسْقِ مَنْ سَقَانِي

**Translation**

“O Allah, feed him who fed me, and provide with drink him who provided me with drink.”

Duaa 18 – Supplication said to one who pronounces his love for you, for Allah's sake

**Arabic**

أَحَبُّكَ الَّذِي أَحْبَبْتَنِي لَهُ

**Translation**

“May He, for whom you have loved me, love you.”

Duaa 19 – Supplication for the expiation of sins said at the conclusion of a sitting or gathering etc.

### Arabic

سُبْحَانَكَ اللَّهُمَّ وَبِحَمْدِكَ،  
أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ  
أَسْتَغْفِرُكَ وَأَتُوبُ إِلَيْكَ

### Translation

“How perfect You are O Allah, and I praise You. I bear witness that None has the right to be worshipped except You. I seek Your forgiveness and turn to You in repentance.”

## Duaa 20 – When going to Sleep

### Arabic

اللَّهُمَّ أَسْلَمْتُ نَفْسِي إِلَيْكَ،  
 وَفَوَّضْتُ أَمْرِي إِلَيْكَ،  
 وَوَجَّهْتُ وَجْهِي إِلَيْكَ،  
 وَأَلْجَأْتُ ظَهْرِي إِلَيْكَ،  
 رَغْبَةً وَرَهْبَةً إِلَيْكَ،  
 لَا مَلْجَأَ وَلَا مَنَاجَا مِنْكَ إِلَّا إِلَيْكَ،  
 آمَنْتُ بِكِتَابِكَ الَّذِي أَنْزَلْتَ  
 وَبِنَبِيِّكَ الَّذِي أَرْسَلْتَ

### Translation

“O Allah, I submit my soul unto You, and I entrust my affair unto You, and I turn my face towards You, and I totally rely on You, in hope and fear of You. Verily there is no refuge nor safe haven from You except with You. I believe in Your Book which You have revealed and in Your Prophet whom You have sent.”
